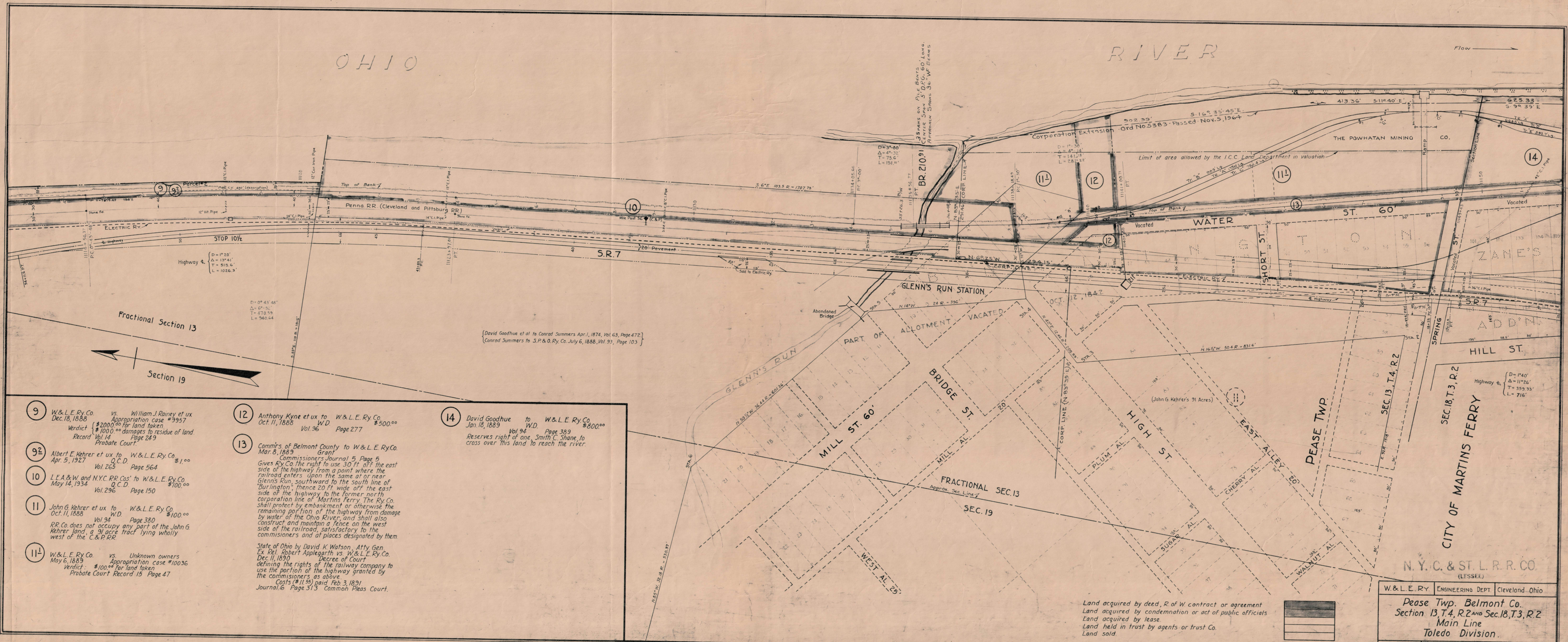

Glenn's Run, southward to the south line of  
Burlington. Hence 20 ft. wide off the east  
side of the highway to the former north  
corporation line of Martins Ferry. The Ry. Co.  
shall protect by embankment or otherwise the  
remaining portion of the highway from damage  
by water of the Ohio River, and shall also  
construct and maintain a fence on the west  
side of the railroad, satisfactory to the  
commissioners and at places designated by them.
